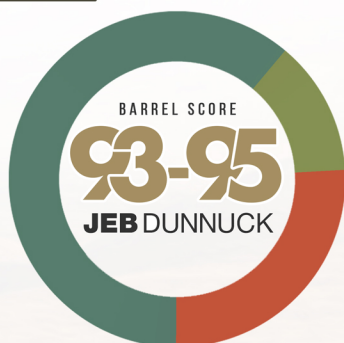

2018 25TH VINTAGE - The 2018 vintage of Harrison Hill offers a **VINTAGE** slightly more hedonistic wine from these cherished older vines, with captivating fruit aromas, led by currant, incorporated into classically restrained and earthy bouquet of tobacco and violets. Lively on the palate, decadent blackberry and mint flavors adorn a classic tannin structure, with an incredibly lengthy finish. Youthful and slow to develop, oak is just beginning to fully integrate; yet balance throughout assures longevity in the bottle.

- 26% Merlot
- 13% Cabernet Franc

WINEMAKING

Cold soaked 24-36 hours, fermented 14-16 days on skin, aged 20 months in 100% French oak (100% new) and aged in bottle 8 months prior to release. 14% Alcohol
